Camper Check In/Checkout Information:

Check In: Sunday, June 28th, 2:30 – 3:30 p.m. **Late arrivals** must wait in cafeteria for check in.
*****NEW THIS YEAR!! Express Check-In** Details below

Checkout: Friday, July 3rd, by 11:00 a.m. **PLEASE** be on time.

Note to Parents: If you are unable to personally pick-up your child at check-out, a written notice (signed by the custodial parent/guardian) is required to release a camper to someone other than the custodial parent/guardian. This written notice should be submitted to your child's counselor upon check-in.

Special Activity Notes:

ALL CAMPERS will participate in daily water activities (water park and/or natural springs area).

Swimming Attire: All campers must wear knee-length swim shorts (board shorts) and **DARK** T-shirts or **DARK** sleeveless t-shirts. Girls: knee-length shorts and dark t-shirts to be worn over **ONE-PIECE** bathing suits. NO BIKINIS, ladies.

If you signed-up for **Ductagami**, please bring rolls of colored duct tape.

Skate Park: All users of the skate park must be experienced skaters. You must provide your own equipment and are required to wear helmet, wrist pads, knee pads, and elbow pads. In addition, a waiver of liability must be signed prior to use.

WAR GAMES: Bring dark or camouflage clothing for evening war games activities. Long-sleeved, tight-fitting "under armor" can be worn under a black or cammo T-shirt for extra protection. Wear long pants, high socks and dark shoes or boots. Dark ball caps or "dew rags" are recommended.

Camp Dress Code:

The camp dress-code is in accordance with Florida College guidelines.

Ladies: Please do not bring low-cut, tight-fitting, or short shirts which show the midriff and/or back; NO tank tops or spaghetti strap shirts are allowed. Shorts must be knee-length, and pants must not be tight.

Guys: Please do not bring tank-tops, body armor (except for War Games), or revealing sleeveless and/or cutoff t-shirts. Body piercing is not allowed at camp.

General: Please do not wear garments which contain offensive graphic or textual displays. Campers are expected to maintain a neat, well-groomed appearance.

Directions to Camp Kulaqua

From South of Gainesville: Drive north on I-75 to exit 399. Go north on US 441 for 7 miles (through High Springs) to the Camp Kulaqua sign on the right. Turn right and proceed one mile to the Camp Kulaqua main gate.

From North of Gainesville: Drive south on I-75 to exit 414. Go south on US 441/41 for 10.5 miles to the Camp Kulaqua sign on the left (just past the Santa Fe River). Turn left and proceed one mile to the Camp Kulaqua main gate.

EXPRESS CHECK-IN

To take advantage of express check-in and drive your child directly to their cabin, you **must** meet the following requirements:

- Camp tuition and any activity fees must be paid in full by June 11th, 2009
- Your camper's medical form must have been submitted
- Parent/camper agreement form must have been submitted

Final express check-in details will be emailed to you after the above requirements have been met.

CAMP REFUND POLICY

- A \$65.00 non-refundable deposit must be made at the time of registration for camp
- Tuition will be refunded in full (except for deposit) if registration is cancelled before June 1th^t, 2009
- Note: This policy is subject to change at the discretion of the directors.
