Camper Check In/Checkout Information:

Check In: Sunday, June 18th, 1:30 – 2:30 p.m. Late arrivals must go to the Auditorium for check

in.

Checkout: Friday, June 23rd, by 1:00 PM. PLEASE be on time.

Note to Parents: If you are unable to personally pick-up your child at check-out, a written notice (signed by the custodial parent/guardian) is required to release a camper to someone other than the custodial parent/guardian. Special Activity Notes:

ALL CAMPERS will participate in daily water activities (lake and pool area). As of 2023, Florida College is requiring a different waiver than we have used in the past. You will receive the waiver via email (Lisa's personal email) and you can return electronically or bring with you at drop-off. We will also have copies available in the cafeteria.

Swimming Attire: **All** campers must wear knee-length swim shorts (board shorts) and **DARK** T-shirts or **DARK** sleeveless t-shirts. Girls: knee-length shorts and dark t-shirts to be worn over **ONE-PIECE** bathing suits. NO BIKINIS, ladies.

Camp Dress Code:

The camp dress-code is in strict accordance with Florida College guidelines.

Ladies: Please do not bring low-cut or tight-fitting shirts. (No yoga pants unless appropriate shorts are worn over them).

Guys: Please do not bring tank-tops or revealing sleeveless and/or cutoff t-shirts. **Shorts must be knee-length**. No tight-fitting clothing of any kind.

General: Please do not wear garments which contain offensive graphic or textual displays. Campers are expected to maintain a neat, well-groomed appearance.
